1. Help set up tables and serve the meal at our monthly meetings.
2. Help greet families as they arrive for monthly meetings.
3. Help clean tables and store food after the meal.
4. Help with child care for children under 3 that attend with their family.
5. Help the group facilitator set up art projects.
6. Help the group facilitator clean up after the projects are complete.
7. Help the children play together during free time in the gym.
8. Help organize a supply drive at your school or Church for craft and project needs.
9. Help the Center for Grieving Children with fundraising by soliciting donations and assisting at other events hosted by the Center.
10. Help distribute brochures and posters to recruit new families and volunteers.

Our group meets on the third Tuesday of each month. Volunteers arrive by 5:30pm. Families arrive by 6pm. A meal is served from 6pm to 6:30pm. We break into groups according to the children's ages. The parents have their own groups as well. The peer-to-peer support group will discuss a topic and complete a project. They spend the final 20 minutes playing together in the gym or games room. The meeting ends with a closing circle at about 8:00pm.
