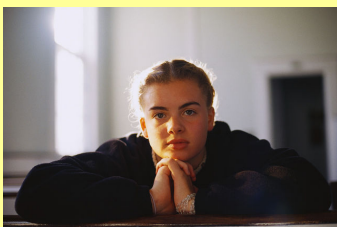
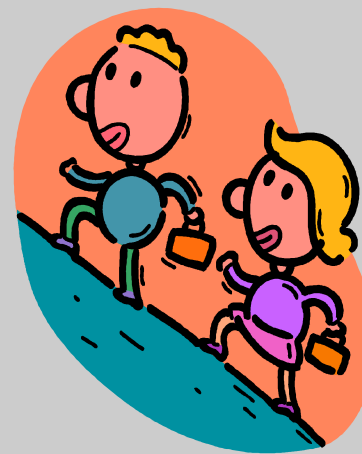

The support program is called CLIMB®, "Children's Lives Include Moments of Bravery." This program was developed by The Children's Treehouse Foundation, a non-profit foundation dedicated to the emotional support of children who have parents or grandparents with cancer. At each session, children will talk about a different feeling and do a craft project that serves as a vehicle for that emotion. Topics include happiness, confusion, sadness, fear, anger and communication. 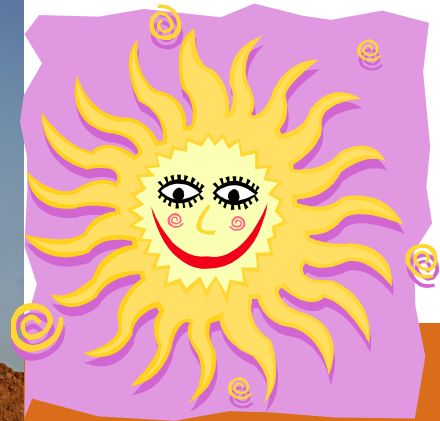
